The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity, as this relates to the meaning for each individual within it.

Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity. In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

Funnel, focal planet Chiron

You have the planetary pattern type called the 'funnel' shape (also known as the 'bucket'). All your planets form a group, with the exception of the focal point, one planet or two planets in conjunction (bucket handle). Your energies tend to be channeled through this focus. You will have abilities in the occupied area of the chart, and goals in the direction of the focal point. The focal planet(s) symbolizes how your energies will be expressed, and where you seek to have your needs met or achieve your purpose. Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.



Chiron in the Second House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for you to face deeply held wounds with regard to your ability to attain sustenance and maintain possessions. With this placement of Chiron, physical resources challenge your relationship. One or both of you may have seen everything taken away at one time or another, or you may have risen above challenging circumstances materially, demonstrate a painful attitude toward material well being. Perhaps you must face fears that possessions dominate the life of the relationship. Where others are able to count on their resources and trust that they will have what they need, either materially, or physically, or within their own psyches, you may find yourselves suspicious that what you have will not last. Even if it is more than adequate by some standards, it seems somehow not enough to satisfy you. These feelings may also spill over into deep issues regarding the relationship's core values, or that which defines it in terms of what you both choose to support and give credence to. You may feel at sea in this area, rather than on stable ground, not sure about what you do and don't find attractive. These ambivalent feelings toward material possessions and values may find their roots in early childhood relationships, in which one or both of you perhaps experienced pain getting what you wanted for yourselves, independent of those who had authority over you. Sometimes these issues are so painful that it is easier not to deal with them directly. Getting in touch with these deep and partially repressed feelings is of ultimate importance for the success of the relationship. When you can confront the parts of yourselves and your relationship that are painful and scary, and begin to integrate the feelings that you have buried away, you will become more in charge of your relationship and the course that you each take through life as well. Composite Chiron in Gemini (or the Third House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for you both to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding the development of the intellect and the communication of one's ideas with others. With this placement you may both feel an almost compulsive curiosity regarding other people. You are likely to share a strong desire to communicate and to explore your world intellectually, but you may feel a barrier that separates you from each other and those around you at the same time. These feelings of being blocked in your ability to communicate can even manifest physically in the form of a very obvious breakdown in your communication. Though these problems may seem almost physical, the physical and the mental are so intimately related it can be hard to say. If there is a psychological reason behind difficulties in your communication, it is likely to be found in your childhood relationships, when it was quite important to communicate with your peers. Perhaps there was some group that you felt cut off from in the casual cruelty of that era, or perhaps you felt that you were not fully accepted by important siblings. In your efforts to gain acceptance and to get through to each other and those around you, you may overcompensate by being competitive or by desiring recognition for the extent of your knowledge. Whatever the nature of the childhood trauma that continues to give you difficulties in this adult relationship, it is important to try to understand and relate well to your earlier selves first. If you can learn to love and accept who you were then, as well as who you are today, you will come a long way toward full participation in your



communication with others. In your quest for wholeness it is quite possible that together, you two will be drawn to helping others to communicate better as well.

T-Square, focal planet Sun

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

With the composite Sun in the Fifth House, your relationship has a creative focus for work and for play. Your relationship may be constellated around an artistic outlet that you share, or it may be that you just have a lot of fun with each other, enjoying a pleasurable release together from daily pressures. In a romantic context, you and your partner will find it easy and natural to plan adventures, to play, and to relax. You do not easily tire of each other, and your shared activity may remain separate from the primary focus of your individual lives. In other words, this composite position works well as an alternative, a break, from full partnership, the quintessential dating relationship. In a committed partnership, there may be children in the picture as an important focal point, and one where each of your own playful sides may really come out. You also may find that you need to draw on other linkages between you to bring in needed depth and durability. In any case, your creativity with each other is likely to be quite high, and you are ideally suited for a mutual venture that allows your self-expression to flourish. This type of activity promotes growth both in yourselves and in the social setting that you find yourselves a part of.

With the Composite Sun in Virgo, this relationship centers on its shared service to others, and in the gathering of the fruits of the material world, as symbolized by the harvest. Regardless of how either of you works alone, you will tend to have a reputation for duty and efficiency when together. You may also find that this relationship lends itself well to organizing and attention to detail. This is the best Sun placement that there is for entering into contracts of any kind, either personal or professional. You will have as your overriding goal an ideal of service to the larger whole. In a romantic relationship, you can temper a tendency toward being critical or overly dutiful with regular ventures into the world of abundance and sensuality that your shared partnership energy also offers. You may find that your shared interests are wide ranging, and that you often get into interesting, analytical conversations with each other and those around you. Your detail orientation also makes you an excellent team as co-workers together. It benefits you to always keep an eye on the big picture, even as you concentrate on each step of the micro.

Important Features

Composite Moon in Cancer (28° Can 07' 05")



Composite Moon in the Third House Leading planet of planetary pattern

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

With the composite Moon in the Third House, your relationship has a strong emotional focus around imparting information. You may find that one of the most enjoyable and rewarding parts of your relationship lies with your ability to share your responses and reactions to the events of your lives with each other. This activity comes naturally and provides stimulation, entertainment and expansion for both of you. In a romantic connection, you are on the same emotional wavelength, and are likely to enjoy discussing everything from feelings, stories and dreams to current events, politics and the general state of the world. You seldom tire of each other and in fact become steady sources of mutual inspiration. Siblings and other relatives may also play a large part in your relationship. Since you have a close emotional connection with each other, it could be difficult to stay objective regarding relationship issues that come up for examination between you, and you could also develop a habit of bouncing from one subject of interest to another. You benefit from cultivating your intellectual interests and stimulating each other to pursue these in greater depth.

The composite Moon in Cancer symbolizes a relationship that provides a strong base of emotional security. This relationship tends to bring out the sensitive and caring side of each of you. You may find that you are protective of each other in this relationship, and that you have the feeling of circling up the wagons and staying inside the safe perimeter that your relationship provides you. You may have joint concerns about the nurturing and protection of each other and of others in your circle. In a romantic relationship, this joint sensitivity can bring out a tendency to be wary of outsiders, especially if you have any other emotional insecurities that might give rise to jealousy. You benefit when you make sure to address and heal real or imagined injuries, rather than give in to an extended withdrawal from each other. As a partnership, you are likely more concerned with private than public affairs.

Composite Mercury in Leo (20° Leo 24') Composite Mercury in the Fourth House Ruler of sun sign - Sun's ruler

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

The composite Mercury in the Fourth House indicates a relationship with an uncomplicated communion around domestic, nurturing and security concerns. You have a natural affinity for each other, with excellent communication skills, especially with



respect to your emotions, which is relatively rare. In a romantic context, this placement makes the process of sharing space much easier and more natural, whether at home or at work. The simple and basic process of getting through the day together becomes a pleasurable exercise. You can easily discuss your feelings, and the dynamics between you, although you may tend to over-analyze the relationship. As a partnership, discussion of your ideas with each other comes second-nature to you. Any shared space that you set up may become the locus of intellectual stimulation and activity. You also may have an unusual degree of access to information regarding your family, and a powerful respect for received wisdom passed down from ancestral sources. Composite Mercury in Leo brings a dignified and refined mentality to your relationship. You are proud of your ideas, and very good at expressing them to each other and to others as well. As a pairing, you are likely to be entertaining conversationalists with good senses of humor. You may also be opinionated at times, with a shared tendency to paint optimistic pictures with your words. You may want to convince each other and those around you of your own point of view, but not be very willing to look at other perspectives. You benefit from cultivating greater powers of attention and perception, and opening your consciousness to each other and to the world around you.

Composite Neptune in Sagittarius (25° Sag 30') Composite Neptune in the Eighth House

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Eighth House (or sign) brings out great personal and spiritual magnetism in each of you as a result of your association. You share a subtle intuition and an unusually clear ability to see into each other's depths, although there may also be a tendency to see each other somewhat through rose-colored glasses. Shared finances may also be subject to a form of idealism or even illusion. You may become more interested in otherworldly affairs, such as psychic matters or occult studies, than the everyday , or find that you share a love of sensuality and luxury together. With this relationship also, you may experience confusion over the power and/or sexual dynamics that come up between you. It may benefit you to put some extra attention into thinking and feeling through these sensitive issues . A process of spiritual transformation may take place in each of you as the relationship matures. You benefit from applying greater clarity to your shared values and to your intimate connection .

Composite Neptune in Sagittarius (or the ninth house) brings an impressionable, idealistic and highly intuitive quality to your relationship. As a partnership, you two are likely to be inclined to the mystical, and high minded, perhaps seeing life in terms of the poetic rather than the practical. You have a natural bent for philosophical discourse or perhaps teaching together, but you may need to guard against over-idealization. Composite Saturn in Libra (24° Lib 21') Composite Saturn in the Seventh House Angular planet - conjunct Descendant

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

The following paragraph emphasized:

Composite Saturn in Libra (or the seventh house) indicates a relationship with a deepening and concentration of your ability to relate well with each other that grows over time. There may be difficulties in establishing a relationship between you, but also great rewards to be gained when you finally do completely connect. There are also likely to be duties or obligations that bind you indissolubly, so that this is one prognostication for a long-lasting bond with each other. Composite Mars in Virgo (29° Vir 12') Composite Mars in the Sixth House Ruler of Rising Sign

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

The following paragraph emphasized:

Composite Mars in Virgo (or the sixth house) brings out a kind energy between you with a strong, shared drive for work and service. Together, you possess a tremendous desire to be helpful to others. You make a practical and hard-working duo with an ability to hit the nail on the head and complete tasks that you have set out for yourself. You may perhaps need to work through getting into conflicts over trifles at times. In a romantic



context, you have a serious rather than a playful attitude toward shared activity. There may be a tendency for unsynchronized timing to arise between you, such when one wants to be served by the other unequally, but these difficulties can yield to a well-developed patience and a sense of humor. You may find greater fulfillment in your relationship when you take turns serving each other. It may prove helpful to you as a partnership to set your exacting sights on wider vistas. You benefit when you learn to see the forest as well as the trees, and to apply your tremendous capacity of effort in ever broader ways to serve others around you.

Composite Uranus in Sagittarius (2° Sag 58') Composite Uranus in the Eighth House

Uranus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter unusual and unexpected circumstances and where the relationship benefits from lack of structure.

Uranus in the Eighth House (or sign) symbolizes a relationship that is willful with an eclectic sense of shared values and an unusual emotional connection. There is likely to be an undercurrent of feelings between you, which may in fact uncover each partner's secret depths. Shared finances are also apt to fluctuate. Your relationship also has the potential for dramatic eruptions under stress, whether physical, financial or emotional. In a romantic relationship the emotional stress that you feel from time to time may be part of the charm of the connection. Sexual passion may have a fitful quality to it, with great intensity at times, and also times when you need to take space from each other. You may also feel that you are psychically linked, and be able to tune in on each other's feelings from a distance. You may also experience joint loss through the sudden departure or unexpected death of a loved one. If so, such a trial may serve an underlying purpose in your shared life and go a long way to deepen intimacy and understanding between you. As a partnership, you share a keen intuition and great power to transform yourselves and your relationship as you evolve. You also may share an unconventional fascination with sexuality, or issues of death and rebirth. With this placement you two tend to share strong religious, or religious-like beliefs, although perhaps expressed in an unconventional manner. In a romantic relationship you have a harmonious higher mind connection with each other and will always have plenty to discuss. You are likely to enjoy the exploration of new horizons together, either mentally or through travel, and you might need to be ready to jump into the car at a moment's notice. You share a powerful sense of optimism and a tendency for reckless behavior at times, since together you may not always look before you leap, and you benefit from exercising



caution when it is appropriate to do so. As a partnership you possess high ideals, and share a capacity to visualize new possibilities rather than accept an outmoded status quo. You may have come together in part in order to support each other through this very process. At your best, you have the faith to bring forth, in leaps and bounds, a new vision for yourself and society at large.

Composite Venus in Libra (0° Lib 25') Composite Venus in the Sixth House

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the Sixth House (or sign) indicates a relationship where concepts of service are highly valued between you. This partnership thrives on the simple day-to-day process of life and living, where each of you is likely to be of help and to support the other partner. You are each well aware of the nature of your partner's ability to serve, and you may mutually desire to be of help in the world, organizing for and caring for others that you have dealings with. In a romantic relationship, this can be a difficult placement, especially if your interest in helping each other may be construed as servitude rather than freely given. It may feel like one of you is more selflessly motivated than the other. Although this behavior is likely to represent a powerful appeal to the other partner, there could be problems that you encounter along the way if you do not talk things out with each other and get clear regarding your expectations. If there are other ways that you connect, then this service orientation can be a great blessing, but in and of itself it may seem more like work than play, and play is very important in love relationships. As a partnership, you may possess a strong shared commitment to work for a cause that you espouse. Together you have a bent toward organization and refinement of your mutually held skills and an inherent interest in the health and perfection of the physical body.

With composite Venus in Libra (or the seventh house) your relationship has a strong emotional support with plenty of warmth between you. Your relationship is founded upon good will and mutual admiration, and others around you are aware of the appeal that you have for each other. As a partnership you appear charming and gracious, and may be known by others as a cheerful and generous pairing. You will generally speaking have success with financial matters. In a romantic relationship, this is a very good placement and ensures a high degree of affection and caring between you. You are each happy to be in relationship, it matters to you, and because you share these values, this particular one feels like a continuing blessing. Together you are gentle and kind with each other and possess refined aesthetic and artistic sensibilities, and a keen sense of color. If you go into business, public relations will be a strong suit of whatever ventures you decide to tackle. You have the joint capacity to excel in many professions, including legal work and diplomacy.



Composite Jupiter in Scorpio (20° Sco 07') Composite Jupiter in the Seventh House

Jupiter in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will find mutual good fortune and faith in positive outcomes.

Jupiter in the Seventh House (or sign) emphasizes the refined and idealistic aspects of your relationship. You two tend to experience the relationship itself as the true source of your shared happiness and this placement is one of the very best for romantic relationships. Together, you work well with other people, and may become known for your fairness. You each grow when you engage in these kinds of activities. You may form the type of partnership that will make a habit of championing both sides of a dispute and making sure that the underdog has his say. You may also be outwardly-directed as a partnership, and concerned with what others might think. Ina romantic relationship, you are likely to find enjoyment everywhere together. Your relationship grows through exploring art and beauty wherever you may find it. You benefit when you develop your shared capacity to stop and smell the flowers and follow your energy to serve each other and the relationship, so that rather than pursuing the socially derived mandate to steam ahead, you allow your focus to be on simply getting your boat down the river.

Composite Jupiter in Scorpio (or the eighth house) magnifies the capacity for shrewd and careful teamwork in your relationship. You two might also be somewhat secretive as a partnership. Together you have strong shared abilities and good luck with joint finances and legacies, or money from outside sources, making this an excellent placement for a business partnership. You have an innate sense between you of what relationship is and where it is going. Romantically, you two are likely to be passionate and sensual with each other. There is a string foundation of shared values and emotional support between you that buoys you up when times get difficult. Your relationship also grows through an exploration of the occult, healing and the tantric arts. As a partnership, you are possessed of good judgment, and a constant sense of what is important to you. You bring tremendous focus to whatever you do, and you make a good working team because of it. Together, you will likely go through many changes as you search for a deeper connection to your higher powers.

Composite Pluto in Libra (26° Lib 12') Composite Pluto in the Seventh House

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

The following paragraph emphasized:



Composite Pluto in Libra (or the seventh house) gives your relationship an intense focus on satisfying your individual needs and desires by pairing up with each other. There may be an almost fated sense of connection between you; that you have come together for some powerful reason. In this relationship, you have a calling to learn all about the nature of your partner's needs and expectations, and there may also be power issues to contend with as one or the other unconsciously tries to dominate. As you sort things out with each other, you will transform yourselves around the issues of balance and control. In a romantic relationship, this transformation toward balance may at first manifest as an unconscious acting out of traditional roles. As you begin to resist playing out old patterns with your partner, a powerful love/hate response may arise in either one of you. Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Aries Rising

The composite Rising Sign is the image that this partnership presents to others and characterizes the nature of the relationship.

With Aries rising in your composite chart, your relationship is likely to be energetic, forceful and outgoing. Things flow easily for the two of you. You are good at getting things done, although you may make better starters than finishers. This relationship tends to bring out in each of you the headstrong and pioneering energy of Mars, your ruling planet, and you are likely to rush into things before reflecting. You trigger great vitality in each other and are likely to be more physically active together than apart. In a love relationship, your feelings are impulsive, direct and passionate. You probably came together quickly, as soon as you met, having recognized something important in each other. You also likely share an acute need for love and affection. With your ego needs involved, you do better the more that you can come to understand how each of your individual needs can be met in the relationship context without sacrificing the other's. As a partnership, you exhibit a strong will, and you may try to dominate each other or those around you. As you grow more conscious in the use of your powers of persuasion, you may learn to be subtler at getting your way. You benefit from incorporating self-discipline into your relationship, in order to channel your shared abundant energy in the most



constructive way possible, for yourselves and for others that you interact with in the larger world around you.

Composite Mercury in trine (fading, 2.6 degrees) with Ascendant Ruler of sun sign - Sun's ruler

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. This aspect between Composite Mercury and Ascendant signifies a relationship that is intellectually sharing. Your logical abilities as a team are excellent. As a partnership you highly value mental pursuits and clear messages. You are rather fond of talking with each other, and your clear communication is a tremendous asset, especially in any form of romantic interaction, since it allows you to keep current with one another. As a partnership, you are quick-witted and glib, and you may turn to writing or public speaking as a way to share your enthusiasm for your ideas. You enjoy exchanging information with each other, and forging communicative bridges with others as well.

Composite Saturn in weak opposition (fading, 6.5 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between Composite Saturn and Ascendant signifies a responsible and stable relationship, but with perhaps some serious limitations to contend with. As a partnership, you are very aware of the ties that bind you together, and you also may feel stifled by them at times. You have some difficulties to deal with in sustaining the relationship, but working through difficulties gives your connection with each other a strength that it might not otherwise possess. On the other hand, there may in fact be opposition that comes at you from outside of the relationship, or other limitations and restrictions that prevent you from fully capitalizing on what might be possible together. On the plus side there is likely to be an achievement orientation to your partnership that can take you far toward established goals, as long as you can mutually agree on what those are. It may also be that there is an age difference or that one partner looks up to the other for guidance. Any hardships that have to be worked through as this relationship progresses may eventually need to be recognized as serious drawbacks or else you may wind up taking them as an indication of the strong bond that remains between you when all is said and done.

Composite Neptune in weak trine (fading, 7.7 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. This aspect between Composite Neptune and Ascendant signifies a highly sensitive, visionary and creative relationship. Your partnership may well be founded on principles of an artistic or musical nature, and you are likely to be sensitive to each other to an extraordinary degree. You are very sympathetic to the needs of your partner. Together



you possess an ethereal quality. In your relationship you may have problems in feeling free to assert yourself so that you evade decisions, or practice other forms of escapism. There could also be issues that come up within the relationship of illusion or even outright deception. Together, you feel a marked remoteness from ordinary reality that may find its natural outlet in poetic or musical expression. Your powerful connection with the spiritual dimension of reality is a wonderful ideal to adhere to and takes you far along your intended path, especially when you can manage to achieve a balance with the practicalities of ordinary life.

Composite Sun in strong square (forming, 0.5 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between composite Sun and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and uniquely idealistic quality. Together you two can be determined to live your own unique vision of life, and love freedom from conventionality. Your relationship has a tendency to experience some instability, and you may periodically create situations, or circumstances may arise from outside, where the relationship crashes and burns, and then begins again from a new foundation. Issues with commitment and responsibility may also arise. You have the capacity to support each other in inventing new approaches and developing original thinking. This way you help each other to push the envelope of conventionality, and perhaps at times stretching beyond the breaking point. In a romantic context, you may also have a propensity to give each other little jolts just where you know it will evoke the biggest buzz, creating tension that keeps things exciting, and can also be occasionally irritating. Your relationship may need lots of space. Give each other a long leash, and you are likely to find a rhythm that includes regular time both together and apart, allowing fruitful continuity. Because your dynamic can be unpredictable at times, it can be hard for others to be comfortable with you. You benefit as a partnership from channeling your energetic and visionary impulses into concrete forms for the benefit of yourselves and the community around you.

Composite Sun in strong square (fading, 1.9 degrees) with Chiron Focal planet of planetary pattern

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between your composite Sun and Chiron you have a relationship with healing potential. You are likely to experience some degree of painful realizations through this partnership, and you also may be able to heal important issues of your own as a result. Chiron is called "the wounded healer" because it represents the archetype



of imperfection and loss which when integrated leads to compassion and understanding of your own and others' suffering. There could for example have been trauma in your early years concerning your parenting or parental protection may have been withdrawn too suddenly or misapplied, and this is the type of issue that you and your partner are striving to bring to conscious understanding in the context of this relationship. Since you have had some experience with these fires of difficulty you are likely as a partnership to be interested in the helping professions, and may eventually assist others, as well as yourselves, in reaching better levels of acceptance and integration of their dark places.

Composite Sun in semi-sextile (forming, 2.1 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information. This aspect between composite Sun and Venus indicates affection and closeness between you but with values that may not always be in sync with each other. It can be of help to create a communication system that allows you to gently address your differing needs in a way that they can be heard and responded to. You benefit when you learn to take turns with each other, to compromise and to experiment with weaving your differing ways into a wholly new and synergistic form.

Composite Sun in inconjunct (fading, 3.1 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between composite Sun and the Midheaven, your relationship has a concentrated focus on intention and a powerful achievement orientation. In a romantic relationship, an active orientation to joint projects that you wish to undertake. You may however differ over the goals of the partnership, and must have the ability to compromise and to provide support each other in your individual career objectives. A drawback is that your relationship may be more susceptible to matters of prestige and other outside influence than you would like. As a partnership you are liable to become very involved with career and outer world affairs, perhaps to the detriment of more private and domestic issues. You may not always reach an agreement on where the relationship is headed, but you are also quite determined in promoting your joint agenda once you arrive at it. You benefit when you strive for the bigger picture in advancing the cause of social as well as personal goals.

Composite Moon in strong sextile (forming, 2.3 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect between composite Moon and Venus brings a loving, calm and steady presence to your relationship, with a refined and artistic sensibility. You two go out of your way to please and accommodate each other and tend to take special care of each other's feelings. You are habitually cheerful in each other's company and likely feel



yourselves to be engaged in a spiritual romance, no matter what kind of relationship you share. You may make better dreamers than doers, but that shouldn't stand in your way; since you travel far on your good vibes alone. This is a wonderful aspect for a romantic connection, and also serves well for parents or for professional colleagues working in an artistic environment. The love between you makes it easy to forgive and forget, and can smooth out other difficulties. Together, you possess a great deal of personal charm, and also have a love for the arts, especially music and dance. You tend to be courteous and popular as a couple, and you go out of your way to be supportive to friends.

Composite Moon in strong sextile (forming, 1.1 degrees) with Mars Ruler of Rising Sign

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect between composite Moon and Mars brings a powerful emotional presence to your connection with each other. As a partnership you tend to experience a sometimes difficult and at other times harmonious give and take, meeting each other in profound and penetrating ways. Although kind and benevolent in your intentions, you may behave with a great deal of intensity toward one another, and in a romantic relationship there can be extremes of anger and love . You can be fierce and fiery with each other in one moment, and passionate and poetic in the next. There is a vigorous and daring quality here. Your emotional responses and your physical responses interconnect so completely you may only learn what you feel after seeing yourselves in action. And when feelings start to arise between you, you may find yourselves acting on them immediately. This creates energy and passion, and in a love connection makes for a sizzling romance. You tend to think deeply together, but you may find yourselves intolerant if you suspect that the other partner is somehow not taking your feelings into account. You may as a unit experience a restless, nervous tension, and it benefits you to engage in constructive activity together as an outlet for all that energy. All in all, you know how to balance well between getting close to each other and maintaining your own sense of individuality.

Composite Moon in strong square (fading, 1.9 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Moon and Pluto signifies a powerful emotional intensity in the connection between you and highlights a moody and introspective quality in your relationship. You may each exhibit something of a power drive, especially in domestic areas or in how you give to and nurture each other. In a romantic relationship especially there are likely to be boundary issues, or issues of codependence, or possessiveness, that come up between you. These emotional issues can lead to stormy weather between you from time to time. Actually, these issues may lie in wait for weeks and even months before showing themselves, but whether acknowledged or not they are part and



parcel of your relationship just the same. The purpose of such a focus on these powerfully constellated emotions that come up between you is to help to bring them to the surface for eventual healing. These may be symptoms that reflect hidden insecurities that rule your behavior from largely unconscious levels of your personality. This relationship challenges you to transform your sense of insecurity by coming to terms with your survival issues based on deep, safe exploration. You may feel an urge to break through emotional limitations that get in the way between you, and this can aid you in healing childhood wounds. Learn to communicate about all the feelings that swim under the surface between you, and you are empowered to discover your core needs. If you allow yourself to change, you have an opportunity to transform your joint sense of insecurity by coming to terms with your survival issues based on a better insight into your own hidden motivations.

Composite Moon in strong sextile (forming, 2.5 degrees) with Chiron Focal planet of planetary pattern

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect in your composite chart symbolizes a relationship in which there is great potential for healing in the area of the feminine and nurturing side of life, as you work together. Of course the important early model for the feminine is mother, and it is likely that one or both you have experienced some degree of painful episodes there. If there were such traumas in your early relationship with your own mother or significant female parental figure, in the course of this relationship these may be helped toward resolution. In a marriage partnership, there may also be issues to be healed with your children, and the mothering and nurturing that they require. Role models may also come into play here, as you expand your understanding of who you really are in the context of this relationship, and provide guideposts for constructive change. Of course it does take work. If you shrink from the task, you may take heart in the fact that these issues will remain, and eventually you will find the way to deal with them. The effort is enormous, but the rewards are just as great. Once you have begun to make conscious the pain and alienation surrounding events from the long buried past, through the agency of this relationship, you can begin to truly be of help others as well as yourselves.

Composite Moon in strong opposition (forming, 1.3 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect between composite Moon and the Midheaven, your relationship has a strong emotional basis with issues around the idea of a domestic or parenting focus. You are likely to have a strong emotional affect on each other, in friendship or a romantic connection. If the latter, you may have a shared vision of living together and starting a family, or there may be potential disagreements in this area. The Moon here indicates that the mothering and feminine side of each of you is a strong part of your



relationship equation and that you have commonly held goals there. The sexual chemistry between you may not sizzle, but your union definitely percolates through your lives in many ways to enrich you both. This makes for a relationship with a nurturing attitude. You will be prone to take care of each other through the course of time, and of others around you that you connect with as a partnership. You may work together to develop a vehicle for your caring and socially oriented values such as a plan to feed large groups of people. In any case you will be supportive of such values as may be in the process of emerging on the world scene.

Composite Moon in square (fading, 3.8 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Saturn, your relationship has a responsible, centered and hard-working basis that also might be experienced as a blockage of emotional connection between you. Regardless of how either of you behave on your own, you may find that together, you respond to each other in unusually formal, or even rigid, ways. Watch for a tendency to withhold feelings, or to stop yourselves before completing a thought or an action. This formality tends to work well in a professional environment. In a romantic relationship, it benefits you to consciously work through this potentially strange sense of rigidity, putting extra effort into the enthusiastic mining of your feelings You may reflect for each other problems you both experienced with the parental care and guidance received as children. You benefit when you learn to cultivate a deeper understanding of yourselves and to discover the roots of your being. This leads to real security and true self-acceptance. When you feel a tendency to slow down or stop in your expression with each other, it benefits you both to push forward. You will likely be surprised at just how much more you get out of the relationship, and of life, in the process.

Composite Moon in trine (forming, 4.9 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. With this aspect between composite Moon and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and unique home base. Your connection is likely to be an unusual one, with a strong intuitive link between you. In a business partnership, you may have come together around the concept of new ways of living. Novelty excites you both. In a romantic connection, you are likely to be extremely honest with each other, and this is a high virtue. You don't do well with anything resembling boredom. You may change your residence frequently, or be always starting new projects and adventures. You may find that you need to take space emotionally from each other at times, and this is actually healthy for you in the context of this particular relationship. You benefit when you take advantage of what this relationship brings, learn to trust in its ebb and flow, and balance your need for security with your urge for freedom and experimentation.



Composite Moon in inconjunct (fading, 2.6 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Neptune, your relationship has a powerful emotional basis stemming from a high degree of sensitivity between you. You tend to be very focused on your joint ideals: your ideal environment, your ideal romantic circumstances, perhaps without ever finding the perfect reality. Together you possess an ethereal quality, noticeable to others, and a strong imagination with a propensity for withdrawing from the world from time to time into internal fantasies of your own making. You may need to be careful not to deceive yourselves about what is going on between and around you or to forget to take care of the practicalities of life on this planet.

Composite Venus in strong conjunction (fading, 1.2 degrees) with Mars

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction between composite Mars and Venus indicates fireworks in your relationship that will inevitably show up, especially when there are other solid links in place between you. In a romantic relationship, you are likely to feel a strong animal magnetism toward each other. You tend to activate deeply held desires within each other and offer the means to fulfill them. If you are friends or colleagues rather than lovers, there still remains a noticeable air of charged chemistry around you. You also may be quite sensitive to each other's energy as a couple and quick to anger, but just as quick to forgive. As a partnership you may find that the complementary balance of give and take between you makes for a strong connection. You also may be very sensuous, especially if the conjunction is in a sign where Mars predominates, such as Aries, Leo, Scorpio, or Capricorn. You likely share interests in music and dance.

Composite Mars in strong trine (forming, 1.4 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is great healing potential around the issues of expressing anger and exerting personal will. It may be that one or both of you have had painful experiences, perhaps in your early childhood, with violence or potential violence on the part of someone close to you. As you continually work through whatever arises in your daily interactions with each other, these types of issues may come up for acceptance and healing. Since the powerful emotions associated with such woundings hover below the level of consciousness it is often the case that your self-awareness around them truly begins to manifest only in your relationship connection. You may also be called upon as a partnership to exert a beneficial influence regarding these issues on others around you. When you become more conscious and accepting of these patterns in yourself, as



you work through them in the course of this relationship, you will less and less need to act them out. A better level of integration is possible, producing a more self-assured and powerful personality.

Composite Mars in strong trine (forming, 0.2 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. With this aspect between composite Mars and the Midheaven, your relationship has a passionate intensity for joint activity. You two are naturally competitive, or at least you are with each other, and your relationship seems to bring out the aggressive edge in each of you. Achievement and activity may be one hallmark of your connection with each other, and you may even have come together around the issue of physical activity. In a romantic relationship you are likely to be seen by others as extremely active and athletic partnership. You have tons of energy for each other and for all kinds of active pursuits, such as hiking and sports. It may be that playing hard with each other is something that not only comes naturally but is necessary for your continued happiness as a couple. As a team your go-getter nature gives you an excellent ability to get things done, and also great drive to succeed. You only need to look out for ego assertion taking up too much of your abundant energy. Mutual career issues are very important for your partnership, and you may achieve much together as you harness your powerful drive in the pursuit of social goals.

Composite Mars in sextile (forming, 3.8 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections. This aspect between composite Mars and Uranus brings to your relationship an unconventional eccentricity, with an original and eclectic mindset and a keen intuition. You two are a strong-willed and nonconformist team, with an aptitude for taking your original thoughts and visions and acting them out in full Technicolor. Probably you came together suddenly, perhaps for some unusual purpose that you were not completely aware of at the time. Together you are energetic and futuristic in your outlook, and your natural talent for inspiring others through your example makes this partnership a strong asset in the business world as well as in society at large. Your basis for action derives from a sense of high ideals, and you have the ability to inspire others to embrace your innovative creations. Your shared goals may also change unexpectedly and dramatically as time goes on, and resist all efforts to define them. If you keep your eyes open, really try to learn what makes your partner tick, and accept what you see, you can make the most of unconventional attitudes and bold behavior. Change and variety excite you both, and your mutability and urge for constant breakthrough may be a strong bonding point in this relationship.

Composite Mars in square (fading, 3.7 degrees) with Neptune



The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Mars and Neptune brings to your relationship a strong idealism and psychic sensitivity together with an inclination to mysticism and the arts. As a duo you are drawn to the subtle and the ethereal. You may also experience a degree of confusion, so that you struggle to find the balance between the practical and the ideal. In a romantic connection, there may be powerful ideals of attraction between you, and your action and goal orientation within the partnership may border at times on deception or illusion. You may be able to fool yourselves into thinking you are doing the right thing when in fact you are blind to your true impulse. You benefit from keeping your communication very clear in order to achieve greater conscious awareness of your inner motivation. As a partnership you may question your own understanding of yourselves and the nature of your relationship. You benefit from clarifying your aims, and learning to focus your intention in order to become a channel for its higher use in your own life and the life of society around you.

Other Natal Planets Composite N Node in Cancer (0° Can 38'R) Composite N Node in the Third House

Lunar North Node in the Third House (or sign). South Node in the ninth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that within this relationship you have the desire for clear and direct communication skills. You are interested in the practical application of knowledge, rather than information simply for the sake of it. This speaks to an issue that one or both of you may feel as though from past lifetimes, that you sometimes get into solitary philosophical concerns in a way that is divorced from the more real world orientation of active one-on-one communication. You especially value being truthful within this relationship, and find that clearly expressing yourself to each other is an important partnership goal. Your mental abilities serve your purpose well. Perhaps religious values are quite important to you, but now, especially in the context of this relationship, your focus is on a more mundane or worldly view, where higher knowledge counts, but only in so far as it is useful in order to spread the word to others. Composite Lunar North Node in Cancer (or the fourth house). South Node in the tenth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that the relationship has a strong need for emotional security. Each of you may feel like you are special, a person of great achievements, and you may in the past even feel isolated in your singularity, as though in previous lifetimes you had spent a great deal of your energy on getting to the top. But as the refrain goes, "It's lonely at the top" and your focus now as you relate to one another will be on getting a better sense of who you really are, at the level of your emotional roots. You will find that as you advance in your life, and especially in the context of this partnership, that your home life is increasingly important to you. Exploring the depths of your beings through meditation or some sort of transpersonal process



work will also be extremely beneficial as you explore your deeper sides. Although as a partnership you may feel tempted to go out and achieve in the world of career and public life, for which you have a natural affinity, it is in the area of establishing a secure base of operations, and of nurturing your immediate community of friends and family that you find your greatest fulfillment, this time around.

Composite Ceres in Cancer (14° Can 20') Composite Ceres in the Third House

Ceres is the first asteroid that was ever discovered, on New Year's Day of 1801, and it remains the largest. It was named for the Roman earth goddess of grain and the harvest. The Greek name for this earth goddess is Demeter. As goddess of the harvest and the natural process of fertility and renewal, Ceres represents in an individual chart the process of nurturing as well as motherhood, and has been experimentally attributed to the sign Cancer as a co-ruler with the Moon, as well as to the sign of Virgo where there is growing agreement among modern Western astrologers that she should be placed. All four major asteroids could be considered as co-ruling Virgo, and they all seem to represent different aspects of the feminine, and therefore could be thought of as further refinements of the lunar principle. An afflicted Ceres, by position or by planetary aspect, may indicate problems with being able to nurture, or to be nurtured by others. This could manifest in food complexes, or a feeling of rejection by parental figures. When strongly placed, she symbolizes the ability to take on parental responsibilities, especially in a female subject, and also may indicate someone who has a close relationship with the earth, as a gardener or grower of food. Also the position of Ceres by house and sign, and its planetary connections, is likely to indicate the way in which motherhood (or parenthood) manifests in the life of the individual. The Third House symbolizes thinking and communication, also traditionally brothers and sisters, writings, short journeys, and also represents your early environment, as well as your powers of analysis and discrimination. Planets in this house indicate how you communicate and operate mentally.

Composite Pallas in Taurus (24° Tau 09') Composite Pallas in the First House

The asteroid Pallas (short for Pallas Athene) was found in 1802, the second of the four major asteroids to be discovered. The four major asteroids, Ceres, Pallas, Juno and Vesta, were discovered within a few years of each other at the beginning of the 19th century, and named for female goddesses in the Roman pantheon. Their discovery has been synchronous with the rise of the women's movement in the West. These four asteroids seem to symbolize four different facets of the feminine and represent a fresh way of regarding the feminine principle in astrology, going beyond the relatively simple categories of wife and mother, as represented by Venus and the Moon. Pallas represents the wisdom of the female spirit, as the mythology of Pallas Athene would indicate: born from the head of Zeus, and symbolized by the owl and the snake, Pallas Athene was a powerful symbol for independence and wisdom in the ancient mythology.



She did not ally herself with any man, but rather was a strong and warrior-like figure who aided men of good will and whose advice was prized for its intelligence. The astrology of the asteroid Pallas indicates such a feminine spirit of independence and cool mental judgment in either a man's or a woman's chart. Pallas represents the creative use of the mental faculty in combination with ageless wisdom, and is also involved with the arts, especially the plastic arts such as sculpture and pottery, and with medicinal remedies. Its position by house and sign indicates where in one's life the divine spark of creative intelligence and higher wisdom may spring forth. The First House symbolizes the acting self, the personality as it appears to others, and the unfolding of one's individual destiny. Its beginning point is the Rising sign/degree, one of the most significant points in the birthchart. The Rising Sign indicates your personal appearance, or self-image, sometimes referred to as the mask you present to the world. Planets in the First House affect your personality strongly. Their characteristics are a keynote of your personality as you express yourself to others.

Composite Juno in Libra (0° Lib 35') Composite Juno in the Sixth House

The asteroid Juno was found in 1805, and was the third of the four major asteroids to be discovered. These four asteroids, which came on the scene just as the 19th century began, represent different aspects of the feminine spirit. In mythology Juno (or the Greek Hera) was wife and consort to Jupiter, and therefore the astrology of Juno represents the partnering energy of intimate relationship. This is also the territory of Venus and the Moon, but where Juno seems to differ is in representing the partnership energy in a new light, as in confronting the more modern issues of where the boundaries are with another person, how much sharing is appropriate, versus holding back, as well as how to deal with bitterness and jealousy, or projected authority and control that is thrown onto another person. Juno also stands for intimacy needs in general. When Juno is prominent in a natal chart, all these type of issues are important to the individual, and if Juno is aspected by another planet, these issues may be colored by the energy of that planet. Juno's position by house and sign is an indication of the area of life in which these issues will be most important.

The Sixth House represents issues of sickness and health, and service to others, including conditions of daily life, or work. This house also relates to discipleship and mastery, and the overcoming of obstacles in producing the fruit of one's achievements. Planets in this house can manifest as challenges to your wellbeing, or as indications of a profession of service to others.

Composite Vesta in Virgo (17° Vir 21') Composite Vesta in the Fifth House

The asteroid Vesta was the last of the four major asteroids to be discovered, in 1807. The mythology of Vesta (or Greek Hestia) is as follows: one of the sisters of Jupiter and Juno, Vesta chose to remain a virgin and not marry. She was the goddess of the hearth fire, which was of utmost importance in ancient times, connoting hospitality and the



basic vitality of the home or city-state, and her astrological symbol is the flame. It is interesting to note that Vesta is the brightest of the four asteroids. Her symbolism also suggests the "vestal virgin" temple priestesses of the ancient Greek world, and their commitment to no man, but rather to their own inner flame of service to the goddess. Their service might even be of a sexual nature, but they remained untouched by any sexual intimacy with another person. In accordance with its mythology, the asteroid Vesta is therefore involved with the signs Virgo and Scorpio. In the astrology of Vesta in an individual chart, these issues of sexuality and completeness unto oneself predominate. Possible associations are the woman (or man) who chooses not to mate, but just as a nun or monk, takes on a higher purpose than normal family life. Vesta may also bring up issues of sexuality and of who is ultimately served in the process, self or other. When Vesta is prominent in the chart, there may be issues with purity, singleness and sexuality either through abstinence or by involving oneself with multiple partners which yet leave the individual untouched by relationship. The placement of Vesta by house and sign also indicate the area of life where these types of issues may manifest. The Fifth House represents creativity and self-expression, also offspring, and is also associated with romance and affection. Following the base of operations represented by the fourth, the fifth house represents the arena in which your personal energies can be released into the world. Any area stamped by your personality, including the display of affection or any creative endeavors such as your artistic expression, is therefore represented by planets in the Fifth House or the sign on the Fifth House cusp.

Composite Eris in Aries (15° Ari 37'R) Composite Eris in the Twelfth House

This is the first trans-Pluto planet to be named, and was termed a "dwarf planet" along with, famously, Pluto. Eris was discovered in 2005 from plates going back to 2003, and was originally nicknamed Xena. In the way of popular myth replacing ancient, Eris is the only planet-type object that was temporarily named for a television drama heroine. The official designation dates from the fall of 2006, and taps once again into the pantheon of Olympian figures described by the Greeks and Romans. This planet, well beyond Pluto, has an orbital period of 556 years, and increases the size of the solar system to double the original diameter. So far as can be determined at this time, Eris represents the first of a series of astronomical objects to be named in the 21st century paralleling the discovery of Pluto in the 20th, Neptune in the 19th and Uranus in the18th.

The mythological Eris, goddess of Strife and Discord, was the sister of Mars, god of war, and willingly accompanied him into battle. She was also the cause of the Trojan War. Jealous of being left out of a wedding, she threw the golden apple of discord into the gathering. When the dust had settled, Paris had abducted Helen and the war was on. It is too early to make a definitive statement regarding all the meanings of this new planetary archetype, but some preliminary indications are as follows. Among the astrological meanings that can be attributed to Eris is one who struggles against



injustice and oppression. She has her war-like and even bloodthirsty side, with the higher manifestation of defending the weak and standing up for oneself. Her placement and aspects to other planets correlate to the archetype of the underdog warrior, speaking truth to power, and with also a willingness to resort to violence if necessary. Many manifestations of this archetype exist in the present culture, and the discovery period is also coincident with the onset of the Iraq war. This archetype represents a dire motif of the struggle for survival that is inherent in the natural world, and in humankind also, and which represents once again, as with Pluto and Chiron, a darker side of our common humanity that must be acknowledged and faced in our time. Where she located in your chart, you have the capability to make a powerful and perhaps ruthless stand for yourself, and to battle against all odds.

The Twelfth House refers to the unconscious and to things beyond the physical plane. It is traditionally associated with confinement and self-undoing, and has been called the house of karma. Planets in this house indicate functions that are hidden from your conscious personality, and are expressed in terms of psychic faculty or self-sacrifice.

Composite Sedna in Taurus (7° Tau 49') Composite Sedna in the First House

The Kuiper Belt object Sedna was discovered in November 2003 and officially named on March 15, 2004, although its status as another "dwarf planet," like Eris, MakeMake and Haumea, has yet to be determined. It is comparable in size to Pluto, only slightly smaller, and when it is closest to the earth it is only about twice as far away from the Sun as Pluto, but its orbit is so eccentric that it can range to distances much farther out. The orbital period of Sedna is likely to be well over 10,000 years. This contrasts with 240 years for Pluto, slightly more for MakeMake and Haumea, and 556 years for Eris, making these far more amenable for astrological work.

The mythology of Sedna provides clues to its astrological meaning. In Inuit myth, Sedna was the daughter of a man who cared for her but who ultimately abandoned her. She was very beautiful, but remained unsatisfied with available suitors and her frustrated father then allowed his dog to mate with her, giving rise to the races of animals and men. Later he suffered remorse and the dog was drowned. She was then affianced to a handsome man who proved to be a nature god called "raven man" with no warm hearth to offer her and from whom she needed rescue. Her father first rescued her by kayak and then consigned her to the waves under attack from the raven man, who whipped the seas into froth with his power. The father even famously cut off her fingers to prevent her return to the boat, and her severed fingers became the creatures of the sea: seals, dolphins and whales. Although her children populated the earth, Sedna remained in anger on the bottom of the sea. The great distance and remoteness of the physical body of Sedna is reflected in the nature of her story and of the Inuit peoples themselves, who dwell so far from the comfort of the temperate zone. In this creation myth we see a theme of the natural world in contrast with the human, and of betrayal and



abandonment especially of the feminine by the masculine. This may well inform the astrological symbolism of Sedna in natal charts as we better come to understand it. The First House symbolizes the acting self, the personality as it appears to others, and the unfolding of one's individual destiny. Its beginning point is the Rising sign/degree, one of the most significant points in the birthchart. The Rising Sign indicates your personal appearance, or self-image, sometimes referred to as the mask you present to the world. Planets in the First House affect your personality strongly. Their characteristics are a keynote of your personality as you express yourself to others.

Composite Moon in strong sextile (forming, 2.5 degrees) with Juno

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Saturn brings an extremely practical dimension to the visionary idealism of Neptune. You two are responsible, compassionate, and take social issues very seriously. You may share an engaging interest in music, dance or film, or in the healing arts. You may suffer confusion regarding restrictions imposed upon you, in which you feel both attracted to the security imposed by such limits, and simultaneously repelled or stifled by these restrictions. With this placement, you the capacity to work with both energies, striking a balance between the Saturn's limits and Neptune's absolute lack of them. At its best, you two will find creative ways to use Saturn's sturdiness to anchor Neptune's visionary quality into practical forms. This placement can also indicate a relationship that has reached a level of spiritual attainment where you share a deep, subtle acceptance of whatever is happening. This state of acceptance is no small thing, and in fact, it lies at the very heart of the esoteric teachings within most of the great religions.

Composite Saturn in strong conjunction (forming, 1.9 degrees) with Pluto

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets. This aspect between composite Saturn and Pluto brings forcefulness to your partnership as formidable as a tidal wave and as transformational as a bonfire is to a pile of wood. With this placement, you find yourself part of relationship that comes with a focus on issues of authority, power and control, with also the benefit of radical transformation. Saturn represents the controlling powers-that-be, while Pluto represents the urge to transform, or destroy, this status quo, and in your relationship these energies come together. You two exude a charismatic magnetism that can make you effective leaders, especially if you focus on empowering those who look up to you. In personal relationships, you may have to beware of turning this immense force onto each other. Glossary

Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction — 0° ± 8 degrees	Square — 90° ± 8 degrees
Opposition — 180° ± 8 degrees	Sextile — 60° ± 6 degrees
Trine — 120° ± 8 degrees	Inconjunct — 150° ± 4 degrees

Chart Comparison: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."



- Midheaven: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.
- Natal: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.
- Nodes: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.
- Planets: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.
- *Transits*: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
